- b. Approved the change of the Project Lead the Way Engineering courses at BHS to honors level. (Courses: Introduction to Engineering Design (IED), Principles of Engineering (POE), Digital Electronics (ED), Civil Engineering and Architecture (CEA) and Engineering Design and Development (EDD).

- c. Approved the Character Education Curriculum (Second Step, Steps to Respect, and School Connect). These curriculums will be implemented during remediation periods in the PK-8 grade levels (two days per week) and in the Health curriculum in the 9-12 grade levels.
