
At the session, we will address the following questions:

enjoys watching her students grow and develop an interest in reading and learning. As an ESL teacher, she supports students' language development through reading, singing, and interacting. Ms. Jones enjoys using nursery rhymes and songs, encouraging students to imitate and practice various language functions and patterns. She explains that "the language songs benefit English Learners in learning to

read, developing phonological awareness, and practicing high-frequency reading words (common words that appear frequently and are grade-level appropriate)." Ms. Jones also incorporates role play and movement into her learning activities and believes in what Bev Bos said, "If it hasn't been in the hand and the body, it can't be in the brain."

One of Ms. Jones' favorite books is The Cray-

on Box that Talked by Shane DeRolf because it expresses the importance of acceptance and cultural diversity.

Ms. Jones recently taught in the district's summer enrichment program and loved incorporating story play into her activities. The students created props and acted out books and nursery rhymes. She said watching the students perform the stories was a memorable student-learning

Ms. Jones advises new teachers to "embrace a love for teaching because the reward of watching students grow is priceless!"




Environmental Magic Show at Broad
