We have revamped our SafeSchools trainings and requirements limiting the trainings to those topics required by law. Please plan to complete all required trainings by October 31st.

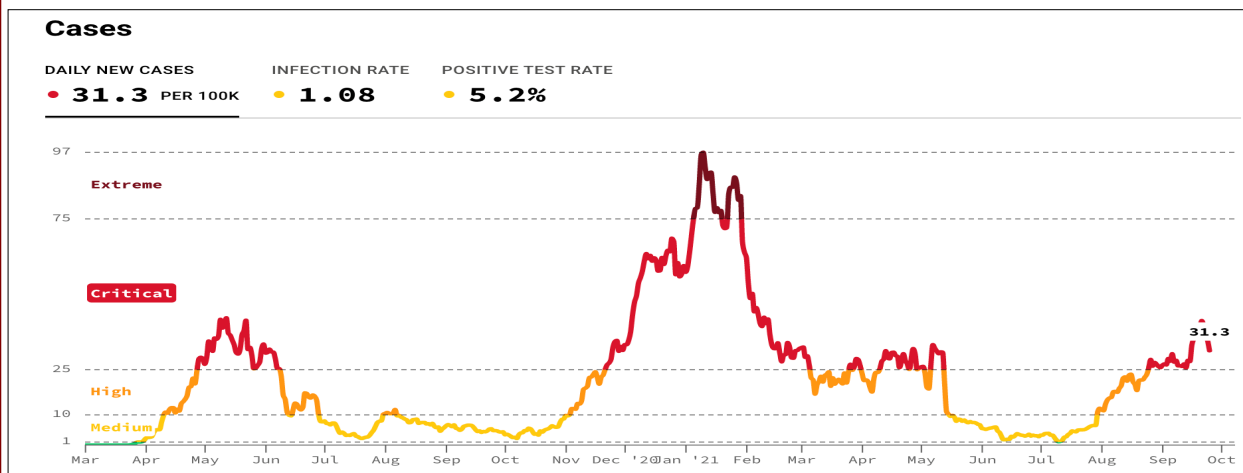

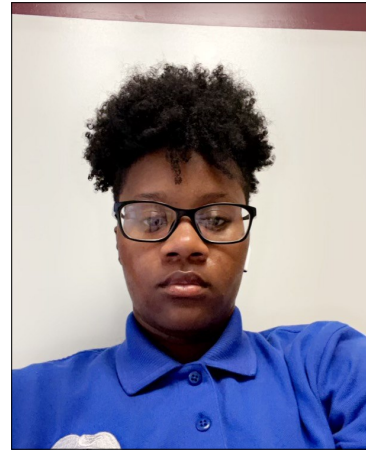

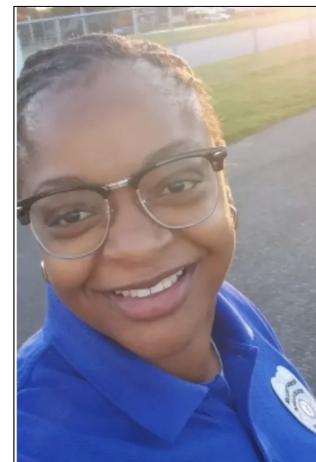
