



Happy Monday Bulldog Team!

Each of you play a very critical role in the success of our district, and I want to say thank you for your service to the students and families of Bridgeton Public Schools. National trends show a record number of educators retiring or resigning and staff transitioning to positions closer to home.

We currently have triple digit vacancies (117) across our district, and will need an all hands on deck approach to staffing our buildings. Word of mouth referrals are very effective when recruiting. Thanks in advance for continuing to spread the word that Bridgeton Public Schools is hiring. You can direct prospective applicants to the employ-ment opportunities section of our website.

Because staffing has been such a challenge, those reporting staff members are routinely doing more to make up for the short fall. In the coming weeks (pending Board approval), we are planning to add 6 additional one session days for students to our school year calendar to commence in January of 2022




