COVID-19 cases remain high in Cumberland County and throughout the state. After reviewing documented anticipated absences on **Monday, January 10**th with the health department due to staff and students who must isolate or quarantine, our district will continue with remote learning for 5 additional days, with students and instructional staff returning inperson on **Tuesday, January 18, 2022**.

Central Office staff, principals, assistant principals, secretaries, and technology staff not under a documented isolation period or quarantine are expected to report in-person January 10th through January 15th to provide any support that families and staff may need with devices or information.

The remote day for students will consist of a full day of instruction, and staff/students will follow their regular schedule. Any instructional staff not in isolation or under quarantine needing to report to the building will need to make arrangements with their supervisor.

Essential (security, food service, custodians, maintenance, and bus drivers) staff's hours will be adjusted. As always, please see your supervisor for your schedules and your in-person reporting responsibilities.

All other staff members not listed above (Guidance Counselors, Crisis Counselors, Nurses, CPISs, Parent Liaisons, Attendance Officers, etc.) should be available to their principals/supervisors for remote responsibilities.

The **Board meeting** scheduled for January 11, 2022 will be held virtually. Anyone who wishes to attend the meeting as an attendee can visit the BPS website to register.

Meal distribution will continue next week. A separate message will go out from the Food Services team indicating where and when families can pick up meals.


