

Happy Monday Bulldog Team!

I hope everyone had a great weekend! This week, 235 of our 6162 students are learning from home. New Jersey's CALI score is holding steady at yellow across the state with some counties in the Northeast transitioning to green. We will be putting out information today to all families and the community regarding continuing with our masking requirement on all district buses, in district office buildings, and in all schools beyond March 7th. We plan to: (1) closely monitor the situation locally; (2) hear the reaction of our parents via our survey; (3) closely monitor our county's move to a green rating, and (4) down the road, relax our masking requirement. As of today, we are maintaining universal masking across our district.



In reviewing this weekend's newly released guidance, the CDC "continues to recommend universal indoor masking by all students (ages 2 years and older), staff, teachers, and visitors to K-12 schools; circumstances in New Jersey have improved to the point where relaxation of universal masking rules in K-12 schools can generally occur." This information can all be found on page 2 of the <u>full guidance</u>. This weekend, the CDC also changed its <u>guidance on masking on buses</u>. Despite this change, our students and staff will continue to wear their masks until we adequately engage our community, and it is safe.

We have built up a lot of momentum around safety and want to be extra thoughtful before moving away




from our protocols and procedures. Thanks in advance for your patience and support!
