

Gabrielle Enders is a Literacy Leader!

After student teaching at West Avenue School, Ms. Enders started her teaching career in Bridgeton 8 years ago. She previously taught 2nd grade and currently teaches 4th grade at Buckshutem Road School.

Ms. Enders loves reading novels to and with her students, and her favorite read-alouds are The Little Old Lady Who Was Not Afraid of Anything and Don't Let the Pigeon Ride the Bus. You will often find her reading her own book during the independent reading time so that the students see she is a reader too!

Ms. Enders took a leading role in implementing Orton Gillingham phonics instruction, and IMSE featured her, along with a few of her colleagues, in an <u>article</u>. Perhaps that is why one of her favorite literacy activities includes playing Wordle with her students to strengthen their phonics skills. She also loves using the videos and question stems from Achieve 3000.

All of Ms. Enders's students track their scores and Lexile growth, and this year alone, all of her 4th graders have completed over 1,200 articles at 75% or higher! On average, the students in the 4th grade grew 75 Lexile Levels within five months.

Ms. Enders would like to remind everyone not to stress themselves out by thinking too far ahead; take it one day or week at a time. She says not to feel guilty about walking away at the end of the day; everything will be there again tomorrow.
