#### **Happy Monday Bulldog Team!**




We are super excited to have 5 Bridgeton High School alumni recently return to BHS to serve as long-term substitutes to support us with critical teacher shortages. Current alumni subbing at BHS are featured on page 3. In future editions, we will feature other alumni serving across our PreK-8 schools. We are extremely grateful for these staff members' service and willingness to support their community! Mondays and Fridays remain our most challenging days as it relates to staff absences per the chart on page 2. Nonetheless, working together as a team, we are managing to provide supervision and continued learning for our over 6200 students across the district. At the height of the pandemic, we were averaging 8% of our teacher absences being filled by our substitute agency. For

the last 2 months, we are seeing between 30% and 40% of our teacher absences filled, which is encouraging.

On the COVID front, I am including two measures below for your review. Our <u>COVID Activity Level</u> <u>Index score</u> has Cumberland County at "moderate" and the rest of the state at "high." Our <u>COVID Act</u>

Now rating has Cumberland County at "low risk" (green) and the rest of the state at "medium or high risk" (yellow or orange). Please continue to exercise caution. While masking is currently optional across our district, on my visits to schools last week, I saw the vast majority of students continuing to wear their masks and roughly 25% of staff wearing masks. For the time being, masking will remain optional and is still optional at 11/12 districts across Cumberland County. We will keep you posted if there is a need to return to universal masking.













## Kelly Jargowsky is a Literacy Leader!
