Happy Monday Bulldog Team!

Today is International Women's Day, a day to pause and salute all the amazing women teachers, leaders and support staff throughout our organization who are making huge contributions to the future of our city schools and our nation!

Since our last briefing, Cumberland County's risk level has been downgraded from red to orange, which is very encouraging and new transmission rates are on the decline. More individuals across our community have received their first shot. First dose vaccinations are up 4.4% from last week (11.5% to 15.9%). Educators are now eligible to sign up for the vaccine at the State's Gloucester County mega site at Rowan University or at most local CVS and Riteaid pharmacies.

Additionally, through a partnership between the district, Complete Care, and our local health department, we have 2 vaccination options coming down the pike. In preparation for these additional vaccination opportunities, all staff are asked to respond to our short <u>3 question survey</u>.

At risk of outbreak

Cumberland County is at risk of an outbreak. COVID cases are either increasing at a rate likely to overwhelm hospitals and/or the state's COVID preparedness is below international standards.



We now surface vulnerability levels for locations. Cumberland County, NJ has **very high vulnerability**, making it more likely to experience severe physical and economic suffering from COVID, and to face a harder, longer recovery.


