

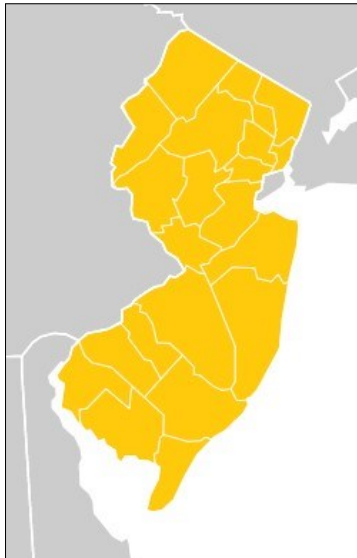

Happy Monday Bulldog Team!



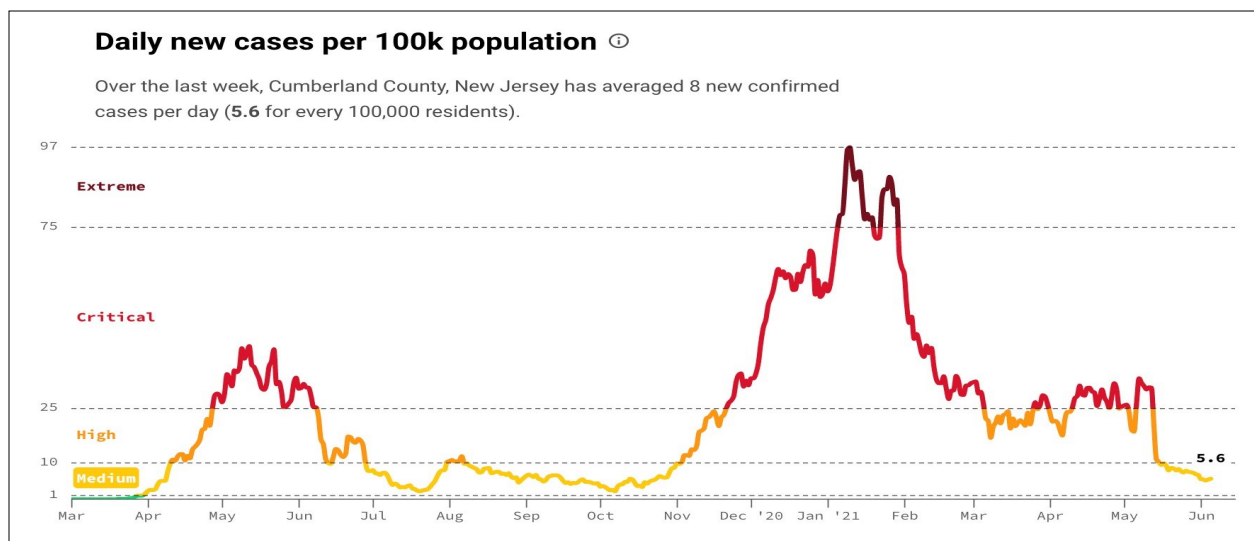

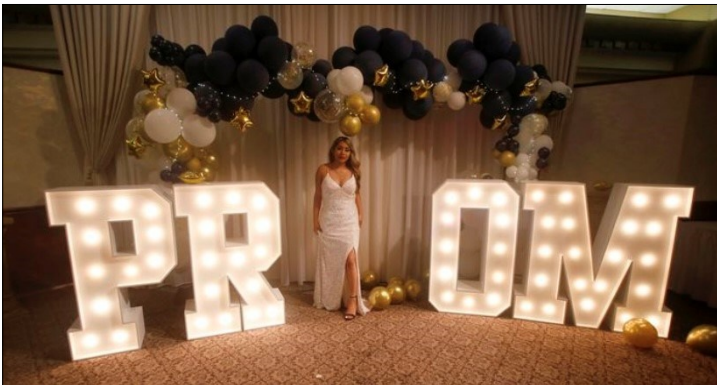

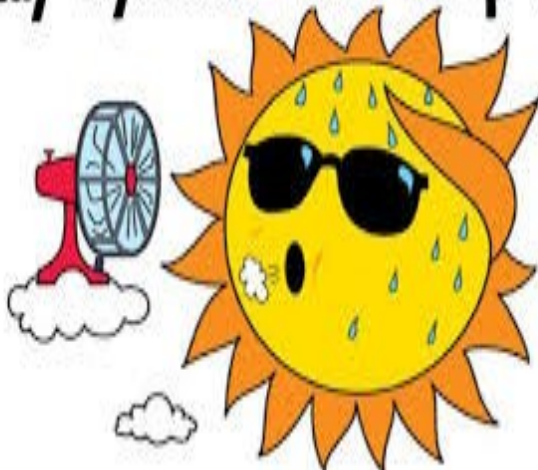
a **PROM** to remember
