### **Happy Monday Bridgeton Team!**

I hope everyone is staying safe and healthy and enjoying the summer. As we approach the fall, I am certain many of you are experiencing angst due to uncertainty around what the school day and schedule will look like. The central leadership team and I will continue to meet in committees to firm up and collaboratively develop our comprehensive reopening plan. The goal is to have our plan Board-approved and available for parents and teachers 30 days before the opening of school. We are also in collaboration with our neighboring districts (Millville and Vineland) so there is consistency across

the three largest districts in Cumberland County. Please note, as we develop our plan, the health and safety of staff and students is and

will remain our top priority.

A preliminary plan has been developed which includes three phases, depending on the status of COVID-19 infections in Cumberland County as we get closer to the opening of school. Our district's Phase I plan involves students in school one day a week for face-to-face instruction, Monday through Thursday, with buildings and buses at 25% capacity for social distancing (25% of students attending on any one school day). Under our Phase I plan, Special Education students will receive 2 days of face-to-face instruction per week, Monday through Thursday. Friday will remain a virtual day for all students along with the other 3 days students are not physically reporting. Our district's Phase 2 plan will involve each student receiving at least 2 face-to-face opportunities a week, Monday through Thursday, with buildings and buses at 50% capacity for social distancing (50% of students attending on any one school day). Under Phase 2, our Special Education students will re-
