I hope as many of you as are available will support our Bulldogs tonight in person or virtually for their homecoming game at against Egg Harbor Township High School at 6 pm!

We continue to closely monitor positive cases of COVID-19 in our school community. As cases throughout the country continue to rise, we are in regular communication with our local health department to determine if and when we might scale back and transition back to 100% remote.

Please understand that while Quarter Mile Lane has seen the most cases, according to the NJDOH and CDC guidelines, the school has not officially met the bar to transition to 100% remote. Still, out of an abundance of caution, we made the decision locally for all staff and students at QML only to work from home for the next 14 school days and resume hybrid instruction on November 9th.

According to <u>CDC guidance</u>, 2 or more unlinked cases would constitute closure. In the cases at QML, all positive cases were linked to the same classroom/case.

Total Positive Cases in Our District since 10/13

- 3 Positive and Confirmed Staff Cases at QML (School is 100% Remote until November 9th)
- 1 Positive and Confirmed Staff Case at BHS (Building currently open and operational)
- 1 Positive and Confirmed Staff Case at Cherry Street (Building currently open and operational)
- 1 Positive and Confirmed Staff Case at Broad Street (Building currently open and operational)
- 1 Positive and Confirmed Staff Case at Indian Avenue (Building currently open and operational)

Communication of Positive Cases to Staff and Families

We have implemented a plan where staff and parents will receive notification of all "confirmed" positive cases as soon as we receive documentation from the positive individual. Where possible and when appropriate, we will also communicate when there is a "suspected" positive case.

Pandemic Response Teams

<u>Pandemic Response team liaisons</u> met with the Superintendent and central leadership team this week, and recommended that we NOT transition our general education students from 1 day to 2 days a week. Liaisons listed the following concerns for not combining Monday and Tuesday students which would mean in some cases 3 and 3 to make 6 or 4 and 4 to make 8 students per class:

- Coverage/staffing concerns
- Cold and flu season
- Rising cases in the Cumberland County community
- Rising cases in our schools

Pandemic Response teams will continue to meet twice monthly and assess our readiness to scale up or need to scale back.

Technology Update

As of October 22, 2020 the district successfully migrated from the old Comcast 1 gigabyte internet circuit to the new 10 gigabyte internet circuit. This should increase the quality and speed of our internet district-wide.
